The Fate of the Boardman River Dams
Resolution of the General Membership - December 3, 2008

- Whereas,** the mission of Trout Unlimited is to conserve, protect and restore North America's coldwater fisheries and their watersheds; and
- Whereas,** a recent poll of the Adams Chapter's 300 members found that a majority of the respondents ranked the option that would "Remove Brown Bridge, Boardman, and Sabin Dams and Retain/repair Union Street Dam" as the most favorable dam disposition option; and
- Whereas,** the removal of Brown Bridge, Boardman and Sabin Dams on the Boardman River will allow for the restoration of the river's coldwater fishery; therefore be it
- Resolved,** that the restoration of the Boardman River's coldwater fishery, by removal of these dams, furthers the mission of Trout Unlimited; and
- the Adams Chapter of Trout Unlimited strongly supports the removal of Brown Bridge, Boardman, and Sabin Dams and the repair of Union Street Dam on the Boardman River

The above resolution was unanimously adopted at the Adams Chapter - Trout Unlimited General Membership Meeting held on December 3, 2008.
